3. Theme: Post Pandemic- The Most Memorable Time That I Cherish. All artwork must depict the theme and intent of the competition.
4. Category:
  - Group A: Primary School (Standard 4-6)
  - Group B: Secondary School
  - Group C: Uni/College
  - Group D: Open Category (Non professional artist)  
\*ONE entry for each participant.
5. Administration Fee:
  - Group A to Group C: RM 10
  - Group D: RM 20
  - Payable to The Kuala Lumpur & Selangor Chinese Assembly Hall (Public Bank 3177 78 4127)
  - All submission of artwork must be accompanied by the payment slip.
6. Artwork Requirements:
  - Format: Drawing must be in A3 size only. (Not applicable to Chinese painting)
  - Media: All media are acceptable except digital media.
  - \* Artwork depicting racial, religious, violence or any forms of illegal and sensitive elements shall be rejected.
7. Artwork Submission:
  - All participants must register and upload their artwork electronically through the Google Form (<https://forms.gle/wKjs2c5eRqQcQ38B7>), the artwork photo must be clear and not exceeding 2MB.
  - Submission Deadline: 30<sup>th</sup> September 2021
8. Award Presentation Ceremony: 17<sup>th</sup> October 2021 @ 11am vide Zoom

  - Primary School:  
Distinction x 3 (RM 100 cash), Merit (RM 50 cash)
  - Secondary School:  
Distinction x 3 (RM 200 cash), Merit (RM 100 cash)
  - Uni/College:  
Distinction x 3 (RM 300 cash), Merit (RM 150 cash)
  - Open Category:  
Distinction x 3 (RM 400 cash), Merit (RM 200 cash)
